The *International Space Hall of Fame Foundation* offers tuition assistance through their scholarship program to prospective summer campers. We believe that everyone should have the opportunity to attend camp. Six (6) scholarships through the *International Space Hall of Fame Foundation* are currently available, each covers half the tuition for the designated programs. Two (2) scholarships are designated for the Mercury program (entering grades 2-3) (\$120 each); two (2) are designated for Gemini cadets (entering grades 4-6) (\$130 each); and two (2) are designated for Apollo cadets (entering grades 7-9) (\$145 each). Application deadline is May 3, 2019. Selectees will be notified on or before May 17, 2019.
